RECOGNIZING OUR PCAT SCHOLARS

The Primary Care Accelerated Track (PCAT) is an innovative 3-year pathway designed to accelerate the journey to becoming an M.D. with a focus on increasing the number of primary care physicians in South Carolina. Following graduation, PCAT participants transition into a 3-year residency in one of the Prisma Health Family Medicine residency programs.

The University of South Carolina School of Medicine Greenville offers a full tuition scholarship in exchange for a 4-year commitment to providing primary care within the Prisma Health organization in South Carolina after residency is completed.
